

Lenten Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

In the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **fast** and **abstinence**. The law of <u>fast</u> obliges all those from ages 18-59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. The law of <u>abstinence</u> obliges those 14

years of age and older not to eat meat.

Lenten Fish Fries will be held during the Fridays of Lent from 5-6:30pm in the Family Life Center. Take out meals will be offered as well. Proceeds go to benefit various programs supported by our local Knights of Columbus Council. Cost per plate is \$12, seniors age 65+ are \$10, and children ages 6-12 are \$8. Please note we will be unable to offer second helpings as we have in the past.

<u>Stations of the Cross</u> will be held at 7pm in the Church on Fridays during Lent.

Please note there are <u>no flowers</u> in the Church during the Season of Lent.


"Where Y'at:? Navigating the Challenges of Life" with Fr. Steve Bruno, Pastor of St. Rita's in Harahan, LA

The St. William Women's Club would like to happily announce its 4th annual scholarship! This scholarship will be available to one recipient who will be enrolled full-time at any trade school or 2-year or 4-year accredited establishment for the 24/25 school year. Applicants must be active, registered parishioners. A 550-1000 word essay and application will need to be submitted to the office no later than April 15, 2024. Once the essays are submitted, they will be given an application number and the essay will be blindly given to the St. William Women's Club Executive Committee. They will collectively narrow the essays down to three. The final three will be presented at the May 2024 meeting and every member in attendance will vote on the essay they feel is deserving of the scholarship. The essay with the most votes will win. In the event of a tie, the executive committee will cast a vote among themselves between the two essays that are tied. The winner will be announced in the June William Tell along with their essay. Upon verification of enrollment, a \$500 check for the fall semester will be sent (in September) to the school of attendance in the winner's name and applied to their school account. A second check for \$500 will be applied the same way for the spring semester (in January) if the applicant is still enrolled and pursuing their degree or trade. The topic of the essay is: How do you see your Catholic faith playing a role in your college experience?
