Woman of the Year Nominations

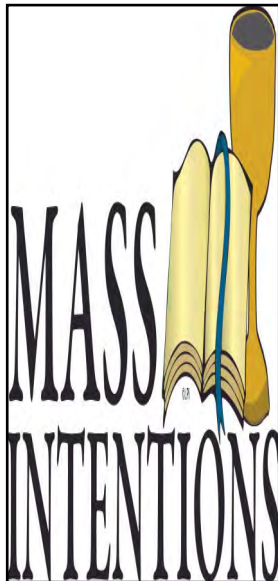

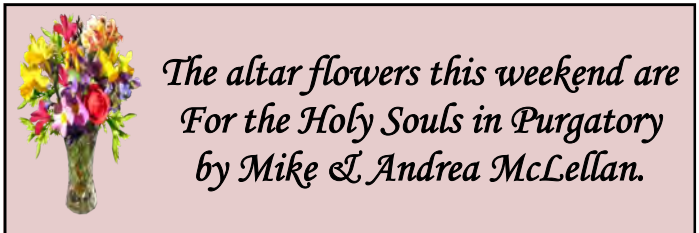

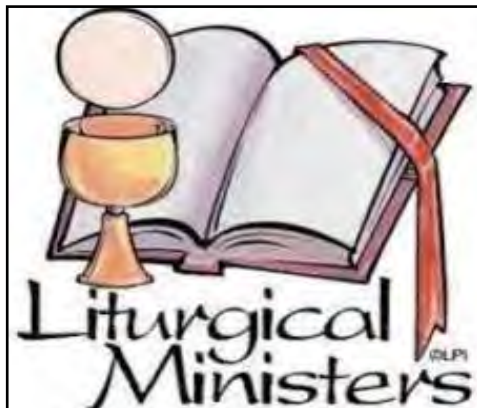
