

someone in need, please gather them up. You can drop them by the parish office during the week during normal business hours or in the game room in the school building on Sundays between the Masses.



Lenten Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

In the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **fast** and **abstinence**. The law of <u>fast</u> obliges all those from ages 18-59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. The law of <u>abstinence</u> obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat.


Out of consideration of our Lord's presence in the tabernacle and for those wishing to pray before or after Mass, please refrain from talking in the church worship space.


