



There will be a Rosary this Thursday, March 2, at 6:30pm in the church. All are invited to attend.




Knights of Columbus Meeting

#### Lenten Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

In the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **fast** and **abstinence**. The law of <u>fast</u> obliges all those from ages 18-59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. The law of <u>abstinence</u> obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat.

office. Essay topic and information about how the winner is chosen is on the application.




