

#### **From Bishop David:**

"This year, the commemoration of St. Patrick on March 17th occurs on a Friday of Lent. While I want Catholics to be able to celebrate on St. Patrick's Day, I also want to respect the important Lenten practices that spiritually prepare us for the coming celebration of Easter. I, therefore, commute the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17, 2023, such that those who choose to eat meat on St. Patrick's Day may fulfill the obligation to abstain from eating meat on any other day of that week."

The Bishop is also encouraging everyone to see every Friday during holy Lent as a day of fasting and abstinence. He will be doing this as part of his Lenten practice.



Out of consideration of our Lord's presence in the tabernacle and for those wishing to pray before or after Mass, please refrain from talking in the church worship space.



#### Lenten Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

In the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **fast** and **abstinence**. The law of <u>fast</u> obliges all those from ages 18-59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. The law of <u>abstinence</u> obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat.

#### Lenten Fridays

Lenten Fish Fries will be held during the Fridays of Lent from 5-6:30pm in the Family Life Center. Take out meals will be offered as well. Proceeds go to benefit various programs supported by our local Knights of Columbus Council. Cost per plate is \$12, seniors age 65+ are \$10, and children ages 6-12 are \$8. Please note we will be unable to offer second helpings as we have in the past.

**Stations of the Cross** will be held at 7pm in the Church on Fridays during Lent.

#### 40 Days for Life St. William Day!



St. William's parishioners will gather for the 40 Days for Life prayer vigil today, Sunday, March 12th, from 1-3pm at Choices, an abortion clinic where they are actively referring women to abortion clinics out of state since abortions are no longer legal in TN!! They are located at 1203 Poplar Avenue, Memphis, 38104. Join us for a complimentary lunch in the FLC after the 11am Mass before we carpool to the vigil. Please text or call Bridget at 901-628-3207 to let her know you are joining in—so we have enough lunch for everyone! Please consider spending time with us on the sidewalk, praying for life! Here in Memphis, our prayers and efforts through 40 Days for Life has led to over 100 babies saved that we know of! If you have any questions, please feel free to call Bridget. What is 40 Days for Life? The visible, public centerpiece of 40 Days for Life Memphis is a consecutive 40 day, 12 hour prayer vigil outside Abortion Clinics and Referral Centers to offer love, help and hope to mothers and their unborn babies. As we pray, we assist the mothers considering abortion—showing them love and offering resources so they know that they don't need to destroy their life or their baby's life. We are a witness to the sanctity of life! The vigil goes from February 22—April 2 and people pray on the sidewalk in front of Choices from 6am-6pm.

"Although each of the faithful always has the right to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, at his choice, if any communicant should wish to receive the Sacrament in the hand, in areas where the Bishops' Conference with the recognitio of the Apostolic See has given permission, the sacred host is to be administered to him or her. However, special care should be taken to ensure that the host is consumed by the communicant in the presence of the minister, so that no one goes away carrying the Eucharistic species in his hand. If there is a risk of profanation, then Holy Communion should not be given in the hand to the faithful." Redemptionis Sacramentum paragraph # 92 from the CONGREGATION FOR DIVINE WORSHIP AND THE DISCIPLINE OF THE SACRAMENT
