The transfiguration is a THEOPHANY-


Theophanies are direct communications or appearances by God to human beings. A few examples in Scripture include: God confronting Adam and Eve after their disobedience in Genesis (3:8); God appearing to Moses out of a burning bush (Exodus 3:2-6); God the Father speaking to the disciples after the Baptism of the Lord, and Jesus speaking to St. Paul in Acts on the road to Damascus. These are theophanies.


Why Moses and Elijah? Standard answer is that Moses represents the (Law) and Elijah represented the (prophets).

But some Scholars say there more to it than this. Both Moses and Elijah had theophanies on Mountains in which they only saw a glimpse of God's glory. In Exodus 33 Moses asked God to show him God's glory and God responds "...you cannot see my face; for man shall not see me and live."

In first Kings (19) Elijah had a theophany: "And behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and broke in pieces the rocks before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice. And when Elijah heard it, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. And behold, there came a voice to him, and said, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"

These men who did not see God's face in the Old Testament are now allowed to see His face in the person of Jesus Christ.
